

# Darwin Harbour Clean Up

This year Conservation Volunteers Australia will deliver the ninth annual Darwin Harbour Clean Up, taking over management of the event from the NT Seafood Council.

In addition to removing marine litter from the waters and coastline of the Harbour, the Darwin Harbour Clean Up aims to raise awareness about the effects of rubbish entering our waterways and encourages everyone to 'bin it or take it with you'.

**This year's event has a focus on single use plastics and their impact on our local marine environments.**

On Tuesday the 10th of July at 8.30am, registered onshore and on water teams across the Harbour will commence their clean up efforts. Collection teams will then deliver their rubbish to two sorting and recording sites: at the end of Fishermen's Wharf (on the rock wall side), and on Cox Peninsula at the Wagait Shire Council Community Centre. Collection teams, program partners and other stakeholders are encouraged to stay for lunch and to witness the accumulative impact of their clean up efforts.
