Specially designed for student groups, this study & conservation tour focuses on teaching the next generations about our global ecosystems and the current global pollution phenomena. During this 5-day program students will have the opportunity to study and participate in on-going conservation activities across South Australia. And spot wild dolphins at the Port Adelaide River!

Itinerary

DAY 1

- Pick up from airport or city to accommodation
- Tour Cleland Wildlife Park
- Back to accommodation for group presentation
- Brief city orientation and dinner

DAY 2

- Early departure for Adelaide International Bird Sanctuary and marine debris activity on the beach
- Afternoon discussion and students learn to sort data collected from morning activity
- Dinner and nocturnal possum survey with group

DAY 3

- Australian Cultural activity
- Wetland studies and conservation activities
- Afternoon group discussion
- Dinner

DAY 4

- Adelaide river or hike trail – koala survey using GPS
- Urban ecosystem experience
- Student discussion – prepare for tomorrow's individual presentation

DAY 5

- Student presentation – certificate presentation
- Depart for dolphin cruise, lunch on cruise
- Estimate finish time in Adelaide city or airport is 3pm – 3.30pm

Conservation Impact

Conservation activities will take place in a variety of coastal, wetland and inland areas. Students will learn and experience practical hands-on projects such as marine debris collection, invasive weed removal and tree planting within National Parks, nature sanctuaries and alongside local Landcare networks and researchers.
