These items are the top 10 most common ocean litter items we have found in our waterway. Help us to stop these items at the source by repurposing, reinventing or inspiring others to change!

1. Foam insulation and packaging
2. Soft plastic film remnants
3. Paper and cardboard packaging
4. Cigarette butts
5. Broken glass fragments
6. Hard plastic fragments
7. Plastic food packaging
8. Sanitary items (tissues, cotton buds)
9. Foil wrappers, packets and alfoil
10. Aluminium cans
