1. Cigarette butts
2. Soft plastic film remnants
3. Plastic food packaging
4. Paper and cardboard packaging
5. Hard plastic fragments
6. Foam insulation and packaging
7. Broken glass fragments
8. Aluminium cans
9. Plastic lids and tops
10. Plastic utensils (straws, cutlery, cups)
