Top 10 Most Common Ocean Litter Items (Parramatta River, New South Wales)

Through **#SeaToSource**, teams of Conservation Volunteers Australia staff and volunteers have been conducting litter surveys along the Parramatta River since September 2020. These items are the top 10 most common ocean litter items we have found in our waterway. Help us to stop these items at the source by repurposing, reinventing or inspiring others to change!

1. Soft plastic film remnants
2. Foam insulation and packaging
3. Hard plastic fragments
4. Cigarette butts
5. Plastic food packaging
6. Plastic lids and tops
7. Plastic utensils (straws, cutlery, cups)
8. Broken glass fragments
9. Plastic wrap (non-food)
10. Sanitary items (tissues, cotton buds)
