

What is a seed bomb?



Seed bombs or seed balls, are small clusters packed with native ground covers or tree seeds that are designed to grow in hard to reach or unsafe areas, like landslips or neglected areas with exposed soil.

Seed bombs protect the seeds inside by encasing them with clay. This mixture protects the seeds from drying out, washing away, or being eaten by birds or other animals.

Rain or water releases the seeds allowing the seed to take root and grow.
